




















NJEDA GRANTS FOR SMALL BUSINESSES



Small Business Lease Grant

Provides grant funding to offset a portion of lease payments for small businesses leasing new or additional space in NJ.

Launched Oct/21



Small Business Improvement Grant

Reimburses business owners up to \$50,000 for costs associated with making interior and/or exterior building improvements, and/or purchasing/installing furniture, fixtures, and/or equipment. Home-based business are eligible.

Launched Feb/22



Small Business E-Commerce Support Program

Provides free ecommerce and digital
marketing consulting
services to NJ small
businesses in the
restaurant, retail and
personal care industries
that operate from a
commercial location.

Launched Feb/23



Main Street Acquisition Support Grant

Reimburses NJ small businesses up to \$50,000 for closing costs related to the purchase of a NJ commercial property from which the small business will operate.

Launched Oct/24







NJEDA FINANCING FOR SMALL BUSINESSES



Small Business Fund

Provides up to
\$500,000 in funding
for eligible applicants
with revenue less
than or equal to
\$3,000,000.
Funding can be used
for working capital
and/or purchase of
fixed assets.



Direct Loans

Provides up to
\$2 million in financing
for eligible New Jerseybased businesses
committed to job
creation and/or
retention in New Jersey.
Funding can be used for
working capital and/or
purchase of fixed
assets.



Premier Lender Program

Provides up to
\$2 million in funding
through the
partnership with banks.
Funding can be used
for working capital
and/or purchase of
fixed assets.
Up to \$750,000
line of credit
guarantee.



NJ Capital Access Fund

Provides up to
\$250,000 in working
capital loans to eligible
businesses and
nonprofits in New
Jersey. Applicants
need to be in business
for at least one year
prior to application
date. No specific
collateral requirement.

HOME-BASED BUSINESSES ARE NOT ELIGIBLE





NJ LEND

Increased access to lending capacity to further support growth and stability of New Jersey businesses—available directly through NJEDA or in partnership with a Premier Lender.



Provides New Jerey small businesses and nonprofits, that are committed to job creation and/or retention, up to \$5 million in loan financing for commercial real estate and equipment and up to \$1 million for operating

- Eligible businesses and nonprofits must:
 - Have at least 2 full calendar years in operation (3 years for nonprofits)
 - Have no more than 750 employees
 - Create or retain one full-time W-2 job for every \$65,000 borrowed within two years of closing (can be a new job, an existing job, or a combination of both)
- Have a 50% of personal guarantors (owners) with a Fees:
 - minimum credit score of 700 (not required for nonprofit)
 \$1000 application fee due at time of applying
 - 0.875% commitment fee due at approval of loan acceptance (Only \$750 for loans with Premier Lenders)
 - 0.875% closing fee due loan closing
