BH Block Party 2026 Check-In Details

Date: Sunday, June 7th, 12-4 pm

BHPD will close Springfield Ave to vehicular traffic from Plainfield to Snyder Ave from 10:30 am to 5 pm. Sherman Ave will remain open.

Check-in: 10:30 am-11:50 am on Summit Ave off Sherman Ave. You will receive the exact location of your booth spot at this time. We will have directional signs, a check-in station with numbered/labeled booth maps, and volunteer staff to help.

Each space will be 10ft x 10ft (unless otherwise arranged) and numbered clearly on the street. You provide tables, chairs, and no larger than 10ft x 10ft canopy with weights on legs to prevent wind movement, a generator (if you need power), etc.

After Paul Neuwirth's retirement and sale of Taylor Rental, we are no longer able to provide tables/tents nor deliver them on Sunday morning. All spaces must be set up by 12 pm with all vehicles off Springfield Ave by **11:45**. You can park your cars in any nearby parking lot or at the train station or by the municipal building.

Block Party ends at 4 pm with space and street clean-up 4-5 pm.
